Sealed bids will be received at the office of the Department of Transportation and Public Works, 2300 County Center Drive, suite B100, Santa Rosa, California 95403 on **November 12, 2009**, until the hour of **2:00 p.m.** (according to the wall clock in the reception area of the office of the Department of Transportation and Public Works). They then will be transferred to a predetermined meeting room designated by the Sonoma County Waste Management Agency where they will be publicly opened and read aloud by the Sonoma County Waste Management Agency or his designee. The Sonoma County Waste Management Agency Interim Executive Director will review the bids and consider awarding the project within 30 days of bid opening.

General Work Description: The work to be done consists, in general, of installing a pre-manufactured building, and such other items or details, not mentioned above, that are required by the Standard Specifications, or these Special Provisions shall be performed, placed, constructed or installed.

At the time this contract is awarded, the Contractor shall possess a Hazardous Substance Removal Certification and a Class B license.

Bids are required for the entire work described herein. The work to be done consists, in general, of installing concrete foundations, pre-manufactured building required to construct the work, and such other items or details, not mentioned above, that are required by the Standard Specifications, or these Special Provisions shall be performed, placed, constructed or installed.

This contract is subject to state contract nondiscrimination and compliance requirements pursuant to Government Code 12990.

Plans, specifications, and proposal forms for bidding this project can only be obtained at the Sonoma County Department of Transportation and Public Works, 2300 County Center Drive, Suite B100, Santa Rosa, California 95403, upon payment of a nonrefundable printing service

Checks shall be made payable to the Sonoma County Waste Management Agency, and shall be mailed or delivered in person to the Department of Transportation and Public Works.

Inquiries or questions based on alleged patent ambiguity of the plans, specifications or estimate must be communicated as a bidder inquiry prior to bid opening. Any such inquiries or questions, submitted after bid opening, will not be treated as a bid protest.

The successful bidder shall furnish both a payment bond and a performance bond for the full amount of the contract.

The Sonoma County Waste Management Agency hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, sex, national origin or other prohibited basis in consideration for an award.

Liquidated damages in the amount of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) will be assessed for each and every calendar day delay in finishing the work in excess of the number of working days prescribed in the contract.

Pursuant to Section 1773 and following of the Labor Code, the general prevailing rate of wages in the county, or counties, in which the work is to be done has been determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations. These wages are set forth in the General Prevailing Wage Rates for this project, available at the California Department of Industrial Relations' Internet web site at <http://www.dir.ca.gov>. Future effective general prevailing wage rates which have been predetermined and are on file with the California Department of Industrial Relations are referenced but not printed in the general prevailing wage rates.

The Sonoma County Waste Management Agency reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any defect or irregularity in bidding.
