

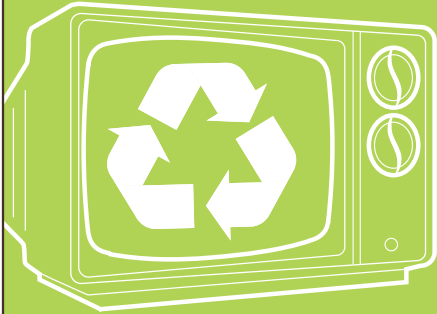


# free e-waste electronics recycling

### What happens to the e-waste?

Electronic devices are mechanically dismantled into commodity streams (dark & light plastic, ferrous & non-ferrous metals, etc.). Recycling proceeds benefit Goodwill's job training program, serving individuals with disabilities and other barriers to employment.

### We accept working/ non-working equipment:

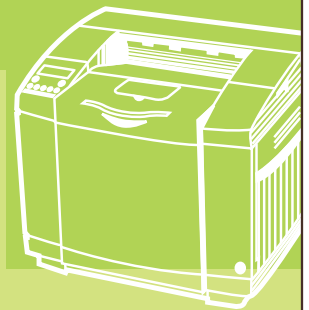
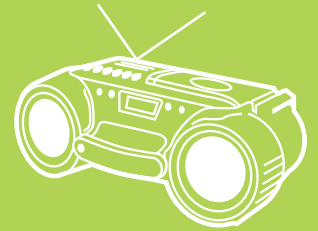
**Computer equipment** (computers & monitors, laptops, keyboards, printers, mice, hard drives, tape & zip drives etc.)

**Consumer electronics** (DVD players, VCRs, gaming devices, PDAs, cell phones, cables, etc.)

**Televisions** (CRTs/LCDs)

**Office equipment** (telephones, fax machines, shredders, etc.)

**Kitchen & household appliances** (microwaves, stereos, radios, etc.)

**Please remove batteries from devices. No fluorescent lamps.**

### We will not accept:

**Large appliances & large office equipment** (refrigerators, freezers, ovens, stoves, dishwashers, air conditioners, water heaters, large copiers/printers that sit on the floor, etc.)
