

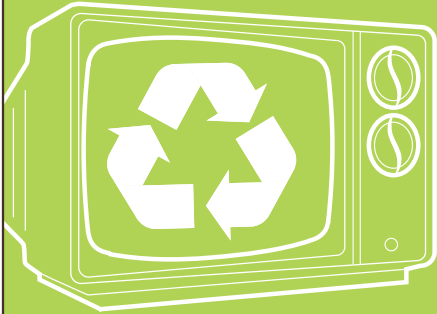

What happens to the e-waste?

Electronic devices are mechanically dismantled into commodity streams (dark & light plastic, ferrous & non-ferrous metals, etc.). Recycling proceeds benefit Goodwill's job training program, serving individuals with disabilities and other barriers to employment.

We accept working/ non-working equipment:

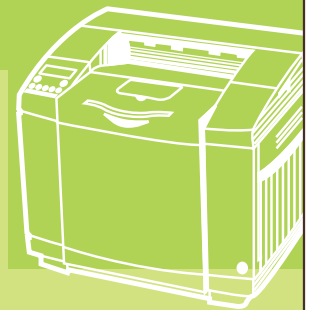
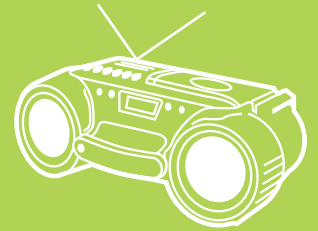
Computer equipment (computers & monitors, laptops, keyboards, printers, mice, hard drives, tape & zip drives etc.)

Consumer electronics (DVD players, VCRs, gaming devices, PDAs, cell phones, cables, etc.)

Televisions (CRTs/LCDs)

Office equipment (telephones, fax machines, shredders, etc.)

Kitchen & household appliances (microwaves, stereos, radios, etc.)
