



HazMobile toxic waste drop-off

No appointment for residents. Small businesses are required to make an appointment by calling 468-9704. Businesses are charged per gallon of waste.

Limit: 15 gallons per vehicle per day measured by container size. Residents may drop-off more than 15 gallons by special appointment for a fee.

Items accepted: Paint, solvents, gasoline, pesticides, herbicides, pool chemicals, acids, corrosives, antifreeze, fluorescent light tubes, medications, toxic cleaners and other chemicals that can't go in the trash are accepted by the HazMobile.

Not accepted: Explosives • Road flares • Ammunition • Compressed gas cylinders larger than 5 gallons • Radioactive materials
• Biological wastes including sharps • TVs, computer monitors & other electronics.

Transportation tips: Place in sealed containers in the trunk, packed to prevent spills.
