

# VISITING DISPOSAL SITES

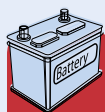
Use of disposal sites is limited to residents and businesses in Sonoma County. Payment by cash or check only. No credit cards.

- Freon appliances
- Air conditioners

- Microwaves
- Ovens & stoves
- Residential furnaces

**Fee:** \$20/appliance that contains(ed) freon  
**Fee:** \$10/appliance without freon



## Batteries

- Lead-acid batteries only, all sizes

**No fee**



## Electronics

- Computers
- TVs
- Printers
- Cell phones
- Answering machines
- Digital cameras
- CD & DVD players
- Radios
- Kitchen & bath appliances

**No fee:** small electronics 25 pounds or less  
**Fee:** \$20 each for large electronics more than 25 pounds.



## Garbage

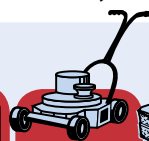
**Fee:** \$108/ton



## Household Toxics Facility

- Garden chemicals
- Automotive fluids
- Expired medications
- Alkaline & rechargeable batteries
- Fluorescent lamps
- Paint

**No fee** for residents.  
**Fees** for businesses.



## Lawn mowers & similar equipment

- Small motor items such as:
  - Weed eaters
  - Chainsaws
  - Lawn mowers
- All fluids must be removed.

**Fee:** \$10 each



## Mattresses

- Any size

**Fee:** \$20 each per mattress or mattress set



## Motor oil & filters

- 5 gallons of motor oil maximum
- 2 oil filters maximum

**No fee**



## Paint drop-off

- Usable latex paint only
- At least half full
- 1 gallon or smaller
- Rust free

**No fee**



## Porcelain

- Toilets
- Sinks
- Tubs

Porcelain only.

Remove hardware, plastic, rubber & seats.

**No fee**

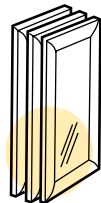

**Free drop-off of recyclables at all County Refuse Disposal Sites**

**Not accepted:** Mirrors • Dishes • Light bulbs

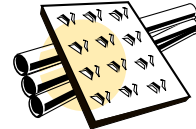
**Not accepted:** Photos • Hoses • PVC pipe • Styrofoam • Vinyl siding • Plexiglas

**Cartons**



Milk cartons  
Soy/rice milk cartons & juice boxes (aseptic packaging)

**Metal, scrap**



Ferrous & nonferrous metals smaller than 4 foot x 8 foot

• Some restrictions may apply; check with on-site attendant
